Course Description:

Introductory sociology is an overview of the work sociologists engage in while scientifically studying societies. Analysis is made of selected aspects of social behavior at interpersonal, inter-group and societal levels. Global and comparative perspectives are explored throughout the course. The main course goals are to develop or improve the student's understanding of major sociological theories, common social science research methods, the basic scientific method, social forces that shape individual behavior, and major research findings from the various topic areas.



Course Objectives:

- 1) Students are able to articulate perspectives on human behavior that are sociological
- 2) Students are able to articulate the role of theory in sociology
- 3) Students are able to articulate the role of social research methods in sociology
- 4) Students are able to define and illustrate key sociological concepts
- 5) Students are able to summarize basic knowledge, questions, and issues in substantive areas of sociology
