Course Description: The purpose of the human sexuality course is to provide students with knowledge about the following topics: social and biological foundations of human sexuality, human reproduction and contraception, cross-cultural perspectives on sexual behavior and contemporary society, gender roles and stereotyping, current and controversial issues in sex education, as well as the effects of socioeconomic status and the political climate on expression of human sexuality. Students taking this course are expected 1. to increase awareness and appreciation of different views concerning sexuality in relation to one's gender, age, sexual orientation, and religious, racial and/or ethnic background,

2. to facilitate open and honest communication about sexuality,

3. to gain a better understanding of themselves and their individual effect on any relationship,

4. and to promote students' recognition of their own particular needs as maturing persons in our society today.
